Basic Farm Tour - \$5.00 per person includes a tour of the farm including the Horse and Cow Barns and an opportunity to visit with the animals of Cracker Box Palace. If you have a large group, we like to break into smaller groups of 10 – 15 people per group. Time allowed to tour the barns and see the animals is approximately 40 minutes. For safety reasons, visitors are not allowed into the pastures, stalls, or pens; our critters love to come up to the fences to meet and greet our visiting friends!

Tractor Drawn Hay Rides – Hay ride is \$3.00 per person (minimum of 5 people please). Time allowed: approximately 20 minutes.

Stay For Lunch – We have picnic tables and folding tables if needed in the side yard overlooking Sodus Bay and the horse, sheep, and goat pastures. Also, if the weather is not favorable, you may use Bunk House Dining Room if it is not in use.

Wildlife Rehabilitator & Educator Krittr Kris & Feathered Friends - \$2.00 per person. Kris is a NYS Registered Wildlife Rehabilitator and will bring some of her raptors and birds of prey for a live demonstration, and provide an educational program about rescue and rehabilitation of all kinds of wildlife. Please...a minimum of 3 weeks notice – all proceeds benefit Kris's Wildlife Rescue and Rehabilitation program.

Nature Walk to 2nd Creek for fossil hunting or to enjoy the scenic water fall. No charge.

Hike our Trails! There are approximately 7.5 miles of trails available to hike or horseback ride (with your own horse), snow shoe or cross country ski on the farm. We ask that you stop by the office and pick up a trail map or just to let us know you'll be hiking or call ahead if bringing horses for parking availability for horse trailers. No motor vehicles are allowed on the trails.

Fall Apple Harvest Tour – \$7.00/person Mid-September through October Apple picking may be combined with a farm visit or be a stand alone visit. Prices include all varieties, including those yummy Honey Crisps! Apples will be available for sale \$5.00 – ½ Peck Bag \$7.00 – 1 Peck Bag

We have some suggestions and guidelines to make your tour safe and enjoyable:

1. Dress for the weather. We are located by Great Sodus Bay, so the weather is usually slightly cooler than inland. And there is a lot of walking involved, so wear comfortable, clothes and enclosed toe shoes. Water proof shoes are suggested as the grass is usually wet even in the late morning. And if you're planning on visiting the creek it goes without saying!
2. Apple picking – Bring a magic marker to label bags. An empty cardboard box is nice to hold the apples while in the bus/car.
3. Visiting the Animals – Cracker Box Palace is a farm animal haven; most of our residents have been abused or neglected and are recovering from life circumstances that you can't even imagine. We ask as a courtesy to our animals that no one runs, chases or shouts at them and please, do not feed fingers to the animals; keep your hands flat-outstretched when feeding the critters. Some of their favorite treats are carrots, apples, peppermints, or animal crackers. Adult supervision of youth tours is REQUIRED at all times. **Children must stay with the supervised group; for safety reasons we cannot allow children to roam freely throughout the farm.**
4. There are farm dogs and cats that run loose. Although friendly, we caution that they should not be chased or grabbed. DO NOT PET THE CATS. They seem friendly but they are working barn cats who are not as socialized as house cats and may bite or scratch. Also, some of our chickens and roosters may peck at fingers. Please don't try to pet them or pick them up. Cracker Box Palace will not be responsible for anyone disregarding this request.
5. The Fossil Walk – It is a hike to Second Creek and everyone is welcome to take home fossils if they wish. But remember, you have to hike back with your treasures so you may want to limit how many you return with...and also save some for others to find!
